Take a look at **NBB Shelters 'Top Tips'** on applying

- Plan Plan Plan funding applications can take several months, make sure you plan as far ahead as possible
- Research the organisation you are applying to for funding, find out about their polices, interests, who they have funded before and what grants are available
- Within your application describe your organisation or school and who will benefit from the grant in as much detail as possible
- Identify what the problem is it might be that there is not enough shade or outdoor cover or there is a need for outdoor seating
- Explain how the funding will benefit the wider community benefits and timescales products you'll need to purchase
- **Detail your budget -** are you also fundraising, if so how?
- Show how your project has the support of the local community
- Take time when completing the application check it for accuracy, include support material such as plans, photos, letter of support
- Focus on the benefits that this project would bring to not only your organisation, but also the wider community
- Spread the word! The more people who know about the project, the better your chances of receiving funding - you never know you might even receive additional offers of funding!

#### How much could I get?

The scheme offers small grants of between £300 and £10,000.

#### Who do they award money to?

Awards for All fund projects that will help provide positive outcomes for not-for-profit groups including schools, health bodies and town councils. A canopy for example, can provide an improved rural or urban environment for the wider community to enjoy.
